 - GOAL(Greek #5056)"Telos"
 - *To set out for a definite place or destination
 - *To point or aim at as a limit
 - *The purpose or result of effort
 - *The conclusion of an action or a state of being
 - LOVE(Greek #26)"Agape"
 - *An abiding affection and benevolence for others
 - *The sacrificial love of God for man
 - *The sacrificial love of Christians for other Christians and those who are not Christians

POINT 2:...of Our Instruction...!

- * As good soldiers of the Captain of the Lord of Hosts...
 - INSTRUCTION (Greek #3852) "Paraggelia"
 - *Strong's Concordance- A mandate; a charge, a command to action
 - *<u>Thayer's Greek Dictionary</u>- a charge or command used of Christian teaching relative to right living.
 - *Vines Dictionary- of military origin. To pass on an announcement, hence denotes to give an order, a charge or command from superiors.
- 1 Thess. 4:1-2The apostle Paul as a good soldier in the Lord's army passes on the Lord's commandments to the Christians in Thessalonica.
- John 13:34-35Jesus Himself commands us to love one another just like He sacrificially loved us when He walked the earth.
