POINT 1: SUBJECTION FOR WRATH & CONSCIENCE SAKE

- * We must obey because of our conscience before God
 - Context of Romans Letter
 The letter to the Romans was near the end of Paul's third missionary journey. Paul was in Corinth for about three months
 - Importance of Authority
 Without civil authority there is chaos and social
 breakdown. Authorities are established by God. To

 God.
 - Obey for both Wrath and Conscience Sake
 We need to be subject to civil authorities to avoid
 punishment. We need to be subject to civil
